Mahatma Gandhi



MAHATMA GANDHI JAYANTI (2nd October)

Gandhi Jayanti is a national festival celebrated in India to mark the occasion of the birthday of Mohandas Karamchand Gandhi, who is called the "Father of the Nation". Mahatma Gandhi more lovingly known as 'Bapu' by all Indians is internationally acknowledged for his doctrine of non-violence that led India to its glorious freedom and this year marks his 152nd birth anniversary.

Bapu was a staunch believer of these ideals and preached that honesty was the virtue of being truthful to self and society. Celebration in Loyola International School

In order to imbibe Gandhi's ideology, our school has commemorated his birth anniversary by organizing a plethora of activities and programs to sensitize his noble ethos amongst our children.

Various activities such as Three wise Monkeys activity, Spinning wheel (Charka) craft, Role play on iconic belongings of Gandhiji, Gandhiji Character play, Poster Making and Short speech were held for all sections of the school highlighting the principles and philosophy of Mahatma Gandhi. The teachers told the children, the importance of what Gandhiji taught and why it is still important today.
