We would like to inform that The Ministry of Education and Higher Education has cancelled the option given to the parents to choose between physical attendance and distance learning. As per the new directives, attendance (On-Campus) is now compulsory for all students on a rotation basis.

Attendance Policy:

- All students are required to attend school regularly as per the schedules given above.
- Attendance is mandatory for both on-campus and online classes.
- **Students not attending on-campus classes will be marked “Absent”.**
- Only students who are diagnosed with chronic diseases are exempt from attending On-Campus classes.
- For seeking exemption from On-campus classes, student must produce a Chronic Disease Certificate from HMC or authorized Medical bodies. (Definition of chronic diseases shall be based on the MoPH list)

We would like to inform that as recommended by MOEHE, and taking into consideration the health and safety aspects of our students, school transport **will continue to be unavailable** until further notice.
