Annual Art & Science Exhibition

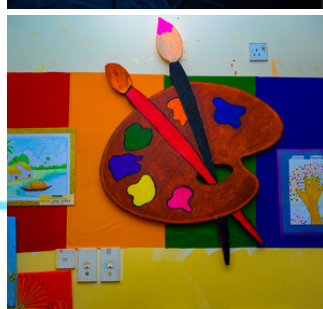
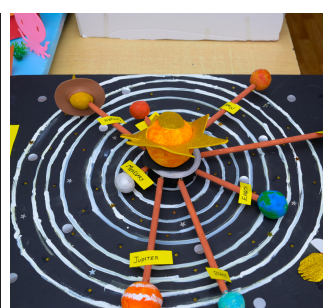
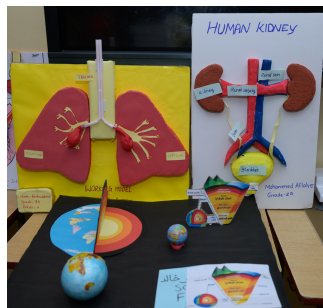
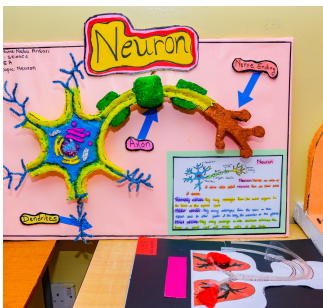
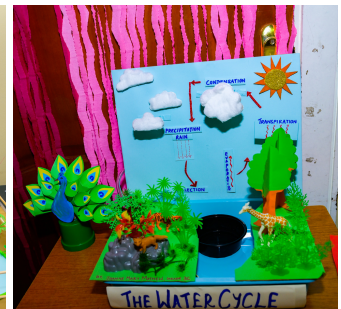
