Here's to wrapping up another successful month and stepping into the challenges and triumphs that await us in the academic year ahead. See you on the other side, ready to conquer new heights!

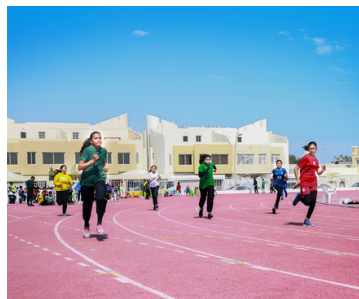
Annual Sports Day

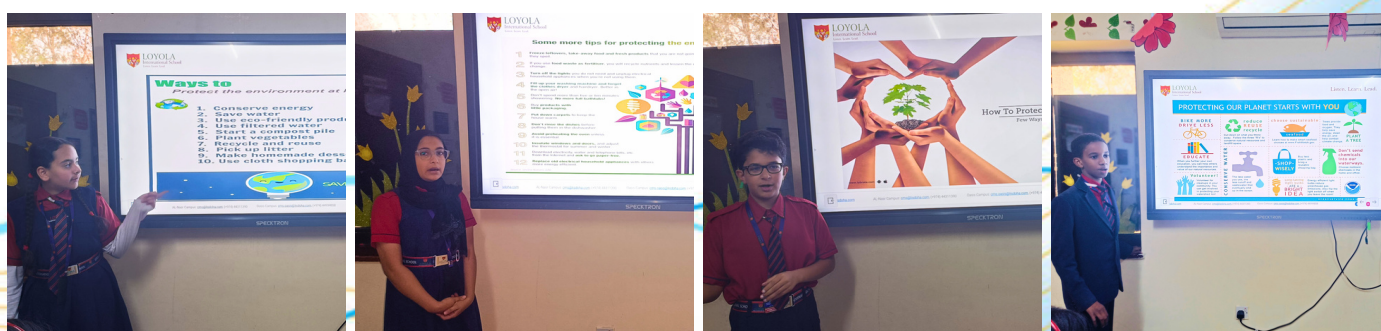
Admiring Science (15 Feb 2024)
