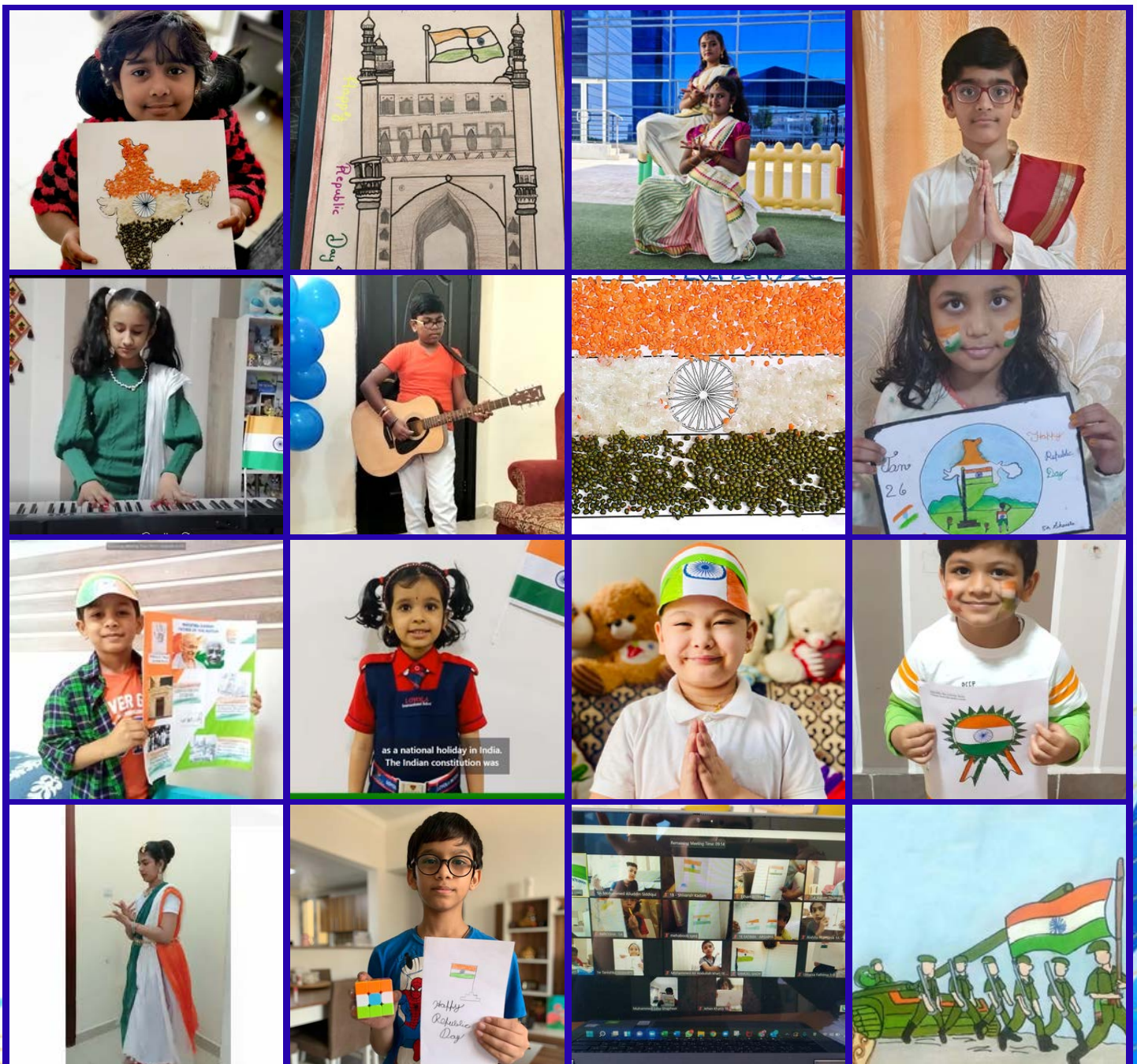

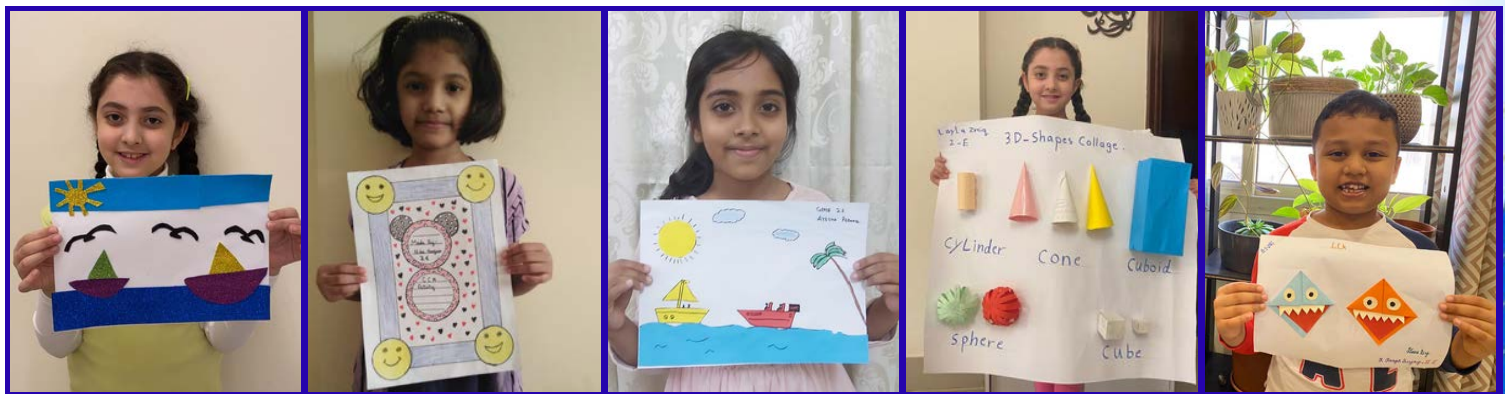
Welcoming the New Year
