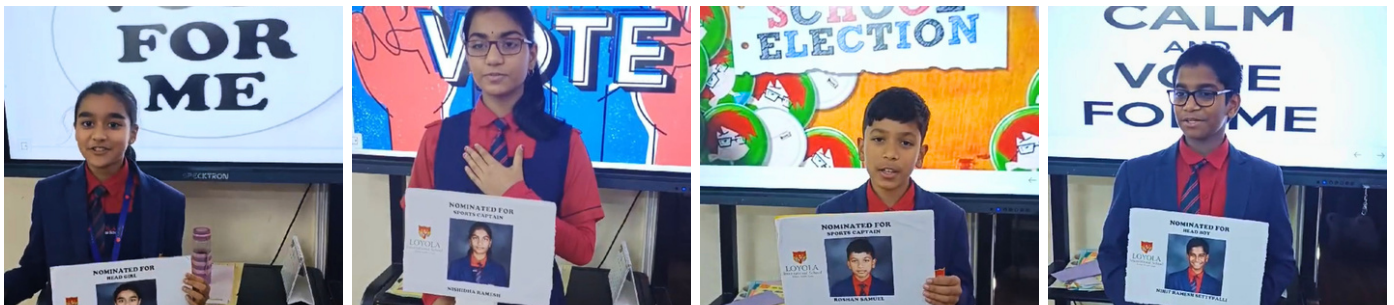
From Ballots to Badges

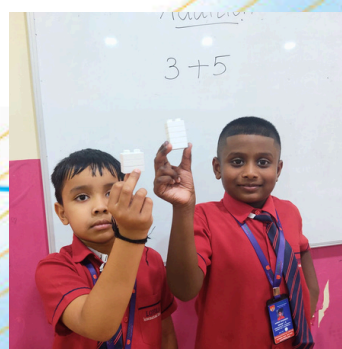
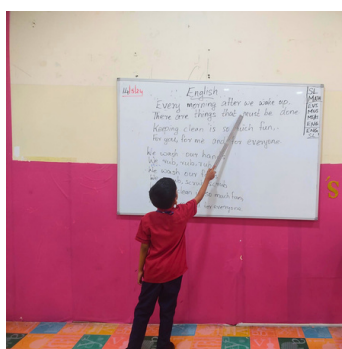
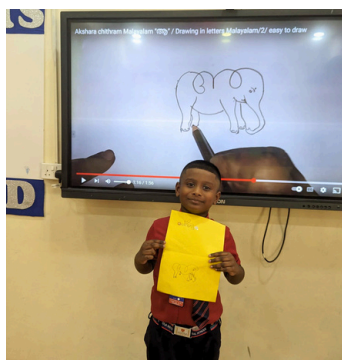
Our students recently had the opportunity to reemphasize their values through various contests and activities. These activities centered around values such as responsibility towards our country, family, planet, as well as towards our fellow human beings. They also focused on the importance of appreciation and empathy.

Through active participation, our students embodied these values in their every day lives.

Subject Enrichment Activities

Grade 1 Highlights!

Our Grade 1 students engaged in a variety of enriching activities that enhanced their learning across multiple subjects. In English, students participated in a poem reading activity titled "Stay Clean," which improved their reading skills and taught them the importance of personal hygiene. In Malayalam lessons, pictures were made using letters and it saw enthusiastic participation from all students. In Mathematics, students explored shapes and patterns by arranging flat shapes into creative patterns, and they practiced addition and subtraction up to 9 using blocks and beads, promoting critical thinking and collaboration. Additionally, in Tamil, students learned alphabets through images and crafted creative projects using chart papers, color pencils, and decorative items, guided by their teacher. These activities not only made learning enjoyable but also helped build a strong foundation in each subject.



Grade 2 Highlights!

In Grade 2, students engaged in various educational activities across different subjects. In English, they learnt about countable and uncountable nouns by sorting them into jars, reinforcing their grammar lessons. In EVS, they created first aid boxes and gave presentations, enhancing their awareness of common injuries and developing practical skills. During Malayalam, students enthusiastically participated in a chart-making activity focused on letter-word associations. In Math, they formed the greatest and smallest 3-digit numbers, deepening their understanding of digit importance and place value. For Moral Science, students made flowers from cut-out petals, learning the value of respect while promoting teamwork and practical skills. In Tamil, they practiced paper folding techniques using recycled materials, guided by their teacher, which nurtured creativity and active participation.



Grade 3 Highlights!

In Grade 3, students participated in a variety of engaging activities across subjects. In English, they created animal shelters using cardboard, grass, and toy animals, learning about the different shelters for animals like cows, sheep, and horses, which enhanced their cognitive and social skills. In Science, students modeled human teeth with clay and cardboard, gaining insights into the differences between human and animal teeth, reinforcing their understanding of the eating habits of animals. During Malayalam, they made charts featuring Kunchan Nambiar, learning about his contributions. In Math, they crafted geometry boats with colored paper, exploring shapes, lines, line segments, and rays, which helped them understand geometric concepts through hands-on learning. In Tamil, they used recycled paper to create crafts, promoting environmental awareness and reducing plastic use, guided by their teacher, which fostered creativity and active participation.



Grade 4 Highlights!

In Grade 4, students engaged in various educational activities across subjects. In English, they explored the importance of a healthy and balanced diet by dissecting "The Pizza Girl" chapter, enhancing their understanding of nutrition. In Hindi, they differentiated between Anunasik and Anuswar through a picture-based sorting activity that reinforced their learning. Malayalam lessons included creating charts related to the story "Thennaliramanum Kallanmaarum." In Math, students learnt multiplication through a hands-on activity involving dice and colorful paper flowers, encouraging collaboration. Science activities focused on oral health, with students making play dough models of teeth to present the importance of dental hygiene. In Tamil, they learnt about recycling by turning waste materials into reusable items, and demonstrated creativity and enthusiasm.



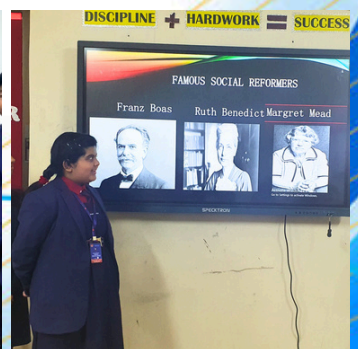
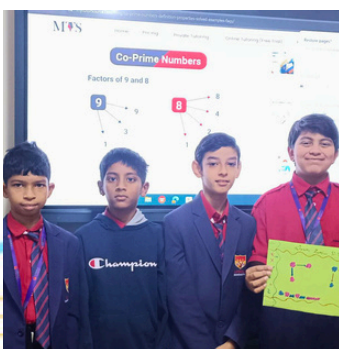
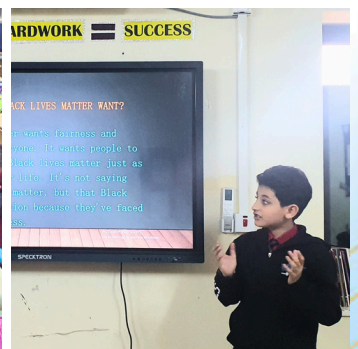
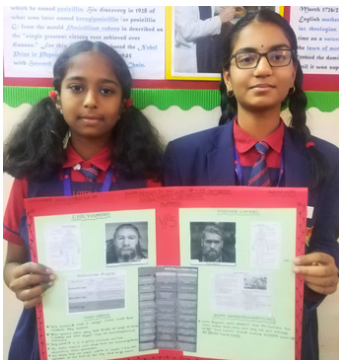
Grade 5 Highlights!

Grade 5 students engaged in a variety of enriching activities across subjects. In English, they read and shared their favorite storybooks individually and collaboratively explored the differences between interrogative pronouns and adjectives. In Math, they enhanced their problem-solving skills through addition and subtraction exercises, preparing for more advanced topics. In Science, they learnt about the human skeleton by building their own models, combining theoretical knowledge with practical application. Social Studies involved researching the Democratic Republic of Congo, leading to cultural awareness and empathy. In Tamil, students crafted sea models, learning about the sea and its uses, while honing their creativity and collaboration skills.



Grade 6 Highlights!

Grade 6 students participated in various engaging and educational activities across subjects. In English, they presented a PowerPoint on the Black Lives Matter Movement, showcasing their research and sparking meaningful discussions about discrimination and segregation. In Hindi, they sorted nouns into proper, common, and abstract categories, enhancing their understanding of language fundamentals. For Malayalam, students drew pictures based on the lesson "Jeevanullapattu," enjoying the creative process. In Math, they explored prime and twin prime numbers, understanding their significance in cryptography and internet security. In Science, they investigated the characteristics of living things through hands-on experiments, fostering critical thinking and collaboration. In Tamil, students crafted birds models and charts, learning about their types, life and migration. In Social Studies, they created charts comparing early and modern humans, gaining insights into our species' evolution and cultural development.

Celebrating Yellow!

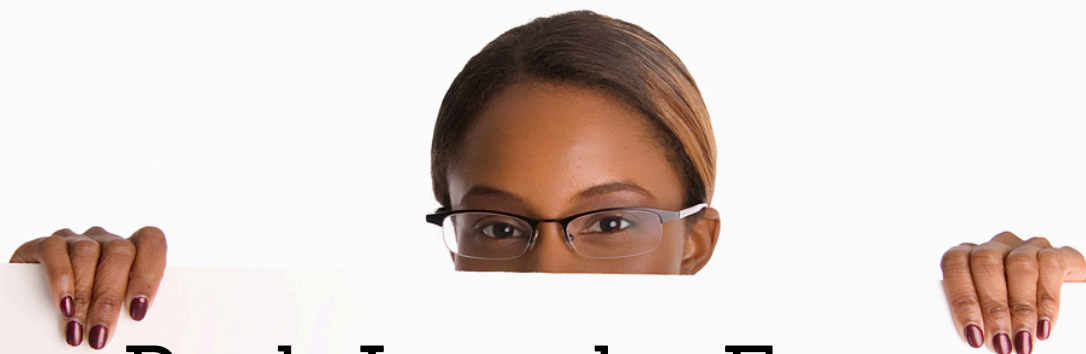
