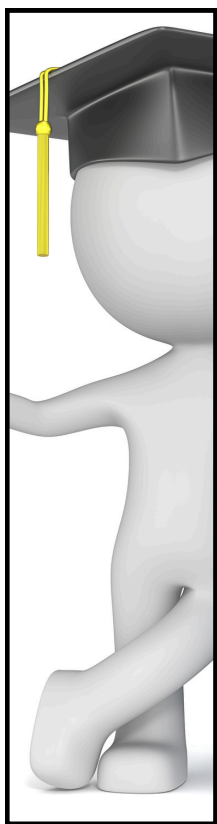
WELCOME

From news reading like anchors to turning historical figures into superheroes, students honed their public speaking, writing, and creativity through engaging activities!



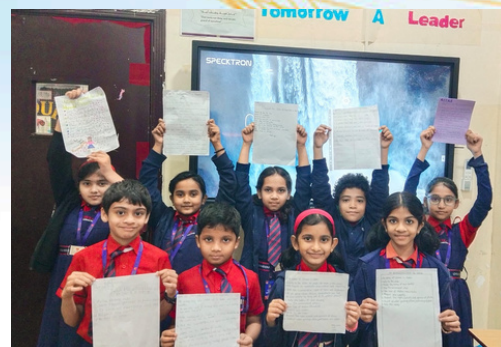
Present & Past Continuous Tense Activity

Students reflected on freedom and duties, creating lists of responsibilities and presenting their ideas to the class. The session helped them explore the balance between rights and duties.



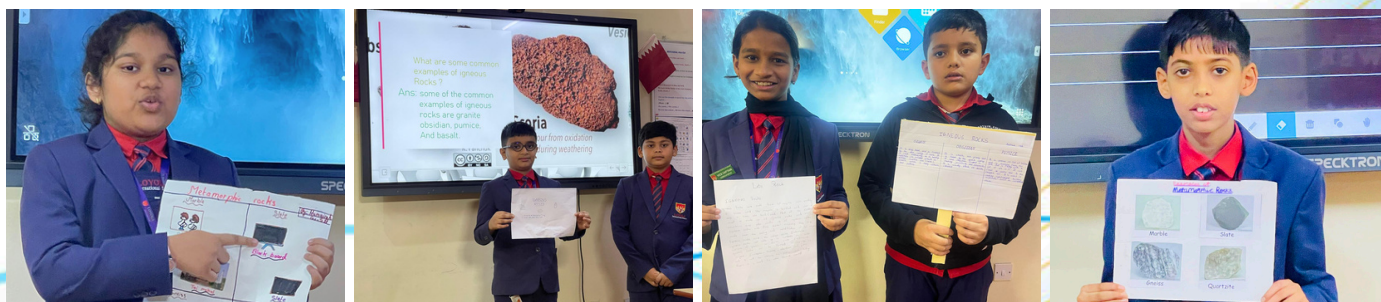
Short Stories with Unusual Characters (Grade 5 English)
